

EU Chemical Regulation 1907/2006 REACh and SVHC

Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, or REACh (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals), is the European Union's regulatory system for chemical substances. This legislation aims to improve the protection of human health, protect the environment from the risks of chemical substances and ensure the safe use of substances throughout their life cycle. REACh applies to the manufacture, import, marketing and use of chemical substances, including those contained in preparations and products.

OTT-JAKOB Spanntechnik GmbH produces power drawbars and, in relation to the REACh regulation, is a 'downstream user' of chemical substances. It is, therefore, not necessary to register OTT-JAKOB products.

Our raw material suppliers have declared that the materials delivered to OTT-JAKOB are registered in accordance with REACh-regulations, if required.

The list of SVHC (Substance of Very High Concern) was updated in June 2015: we can inform you that, to our knowledge, OTT-JAKOB only uses materials which do not include substances of very high concern (SVHCs < 0.1% w/w).

We will keep in touch with our suppliers and will inform you if any changes occur.
